

Instructions for Adult and Youth/Scout Groups

Time on the water here in the Secret Wilderness or on Irondequoit Bay makes for a fun-filled group outing. If you are organizing an excursion at BayCreek for a scout, youth, work or other group, please carefully read these important instructions. It will help your activity run much more smoothly and safely.

Definition of a Group Activity:

An activity (rental, shuttle, instruction, or guided tour) involving 4 or more BayCreek boats.

Discounted Rates:

Special rates are available for groups. TO QUALIFY, THE GROUP MUST FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS. For rates, see:

- Adults – www.
- Youth and Scouts – www. These rates apply only for specific youth and scout organizations, and include adults supervising the activity.

1. Reservations:

Reservations MUST be made in advance. BayCreek may be unable to accommodate some desires based on our capacity and prior reservations.

- Adult group rates apply Monday through Friday only.
- Youth and Scout group rates apply weekdays and 9am Saturdays and Sundays

2. Registration Forms and Waivers:

BayCreek waivers must be filled out in advance and collected by the trip organizer. Download at <http://www.baycreek.com/uploads/Waiver.pdf>

PLEASE NOTE:

- PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS MUST COUNTERSIGN FOR CHILDREN UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE. It is not acceptable for the trip organizer or group leader to sign for those under 18.
- TRIP PERMISSION SLIPS FOR YOUTH GROUPS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE IN LIEU OF THE BAYCREEK WAIVER. Please use our waiver.

3. Payment:

For convenience, all rates are specified on a per person basis. Different rates apply for different boats, the activity and length of the activity. It is necessary that the organizer make one payment for the group, using the form included in this document.

Getting Going

When your group arrives at BayCreek, assemble in an open area. After waivers are presented and payment is made, a BayCreek staff member will assist with PFD (life vest) fitting, paddles and boats.

Managing the Group

If the group is large, please designate a leader and a sweeper. The lead boater(s) should be a competent paddler(s) and should be knowledgeable of the route that the group wants to take. The lead boat manages the speed of the group to make sure the group does not get spread out over too great of a distance. No boats go in front of the lead boat. The sweep boat should be the most competent paddler(s), capable of helping others who may be having difficulty. No boats lag behind the sweep boat.

The BayCreek staff will put the lead boat in the water first, and the sweep boat in last, so please be prepared to identify these parties.
